

**Provincial & Territorial Child Restraint Laws**

<b><u>Alberta</u></b>	Must be properly restrained until age six (6) OR 40lbs (18kg) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>British Columbia</u></b>	Must rear face to minimum age one (1), and 20lb (9kg) Must use car seat to minimum 40lb (18kg) Must use a belt-positioning booster seat until age nine (9) OR 4'9" (145cm) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Manitoba</u></b>	Must be properly restrained in a car seat or booster seat until age nine (9) OR 80lbs (36kg) OR 4'9" (145cm) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>New Brunswick</u></b>	Must be restrained in a car seat or booster seat until age nine (9) OR 80lb (36kg) OR 4'9" (145cm) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Newfoundland &amp; Labrador</u></b>	Must rear face until minimum of 20lb (9kg) Must use a car seat until minimum 40lb (18kg) Must use a booster until age nine (9) AND 81.5 lb (37kg) AND 4'9" (145cm) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Northwest Territories</u></b>	Must rear face until minimum 20lbs (9kg) Must use a car seat until a minimum 40lb (18kg) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Nova Scotia</u></b>	Must rear face until age one (1) AND 22lb (10kg) Must use a car seat until minimum 40lb (18kg) Must use a booster until minimum age nine (9) OR 4'9" (145cm) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Nunavut</u></b>	Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions Must rear face until minimum 20lb (9kg) Must use a car seat until minimum 40lb (18kg)

<b><u>Ontario</u></b>	Must rear face until minimum 20lb (9kg) Must use a car seat until minimum 40lb (18kg) Must use a booster until minimum age eight (8) OR 80lb (36kg) OR 4'9" (145cm) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Prince Edward Island</u></b>	Must rear face until minimum age one (1) AND 22lb (10kg) Must use a car seat until minimum 40lb (18kg) Must use a booster until minimum age ten (10) OR child exceeds manufacturers stated weight limit OR 4'9" (145cm) Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Quebec</u></b>	Must be properly restrained until a minimum seated height of 25" (63cm) *Sitting on the floor, measure floor to top of the head Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Saskatchewan</u></b>	Must use a car seat until minimum 40lb (18kg) Must use a booster until age seven (7) OR 80lb (36kg) AND 4'9" Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
<b><u>Yukon</u></b> <a href="#">Section 86 - Restraint Systems, Page 95</a>	Must rear face until minimum 22lb (10kg) AND walking unassisted Must use a car seat until minimum 48lb (22kg) Must use a booster until 100lb (45kg) OR 4'9" Child restraints and booster seats must be used according to manufacturers instructions
